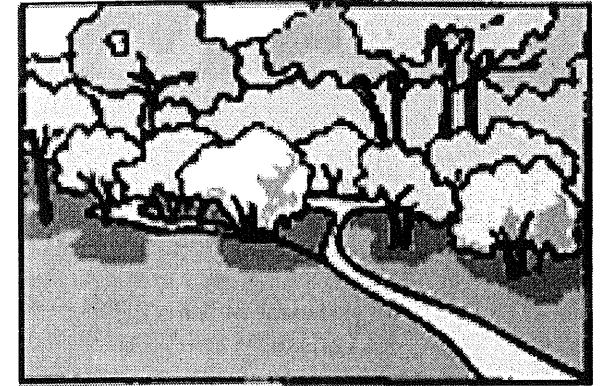


LAKE ICARIA NATURE TRAILS

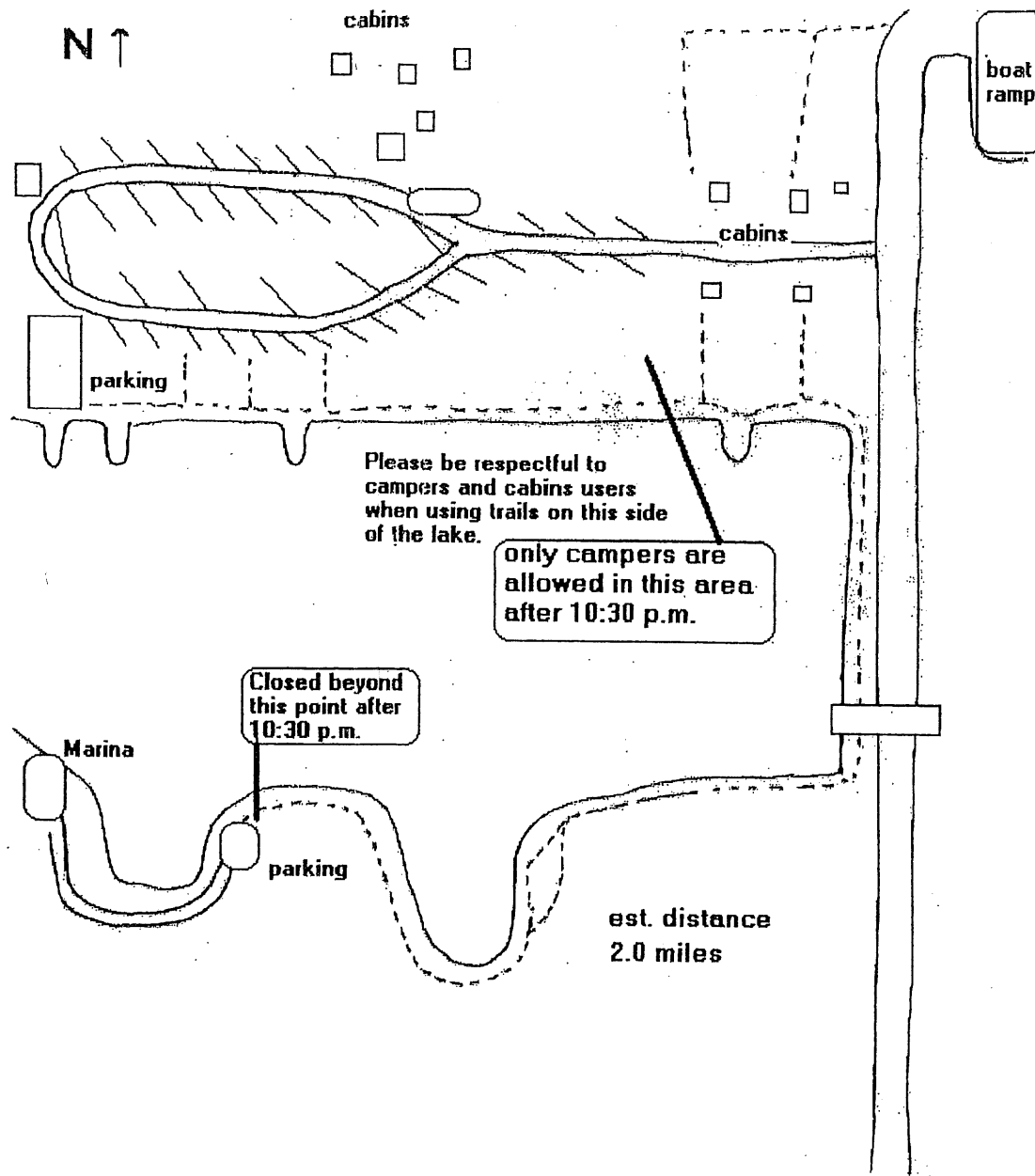


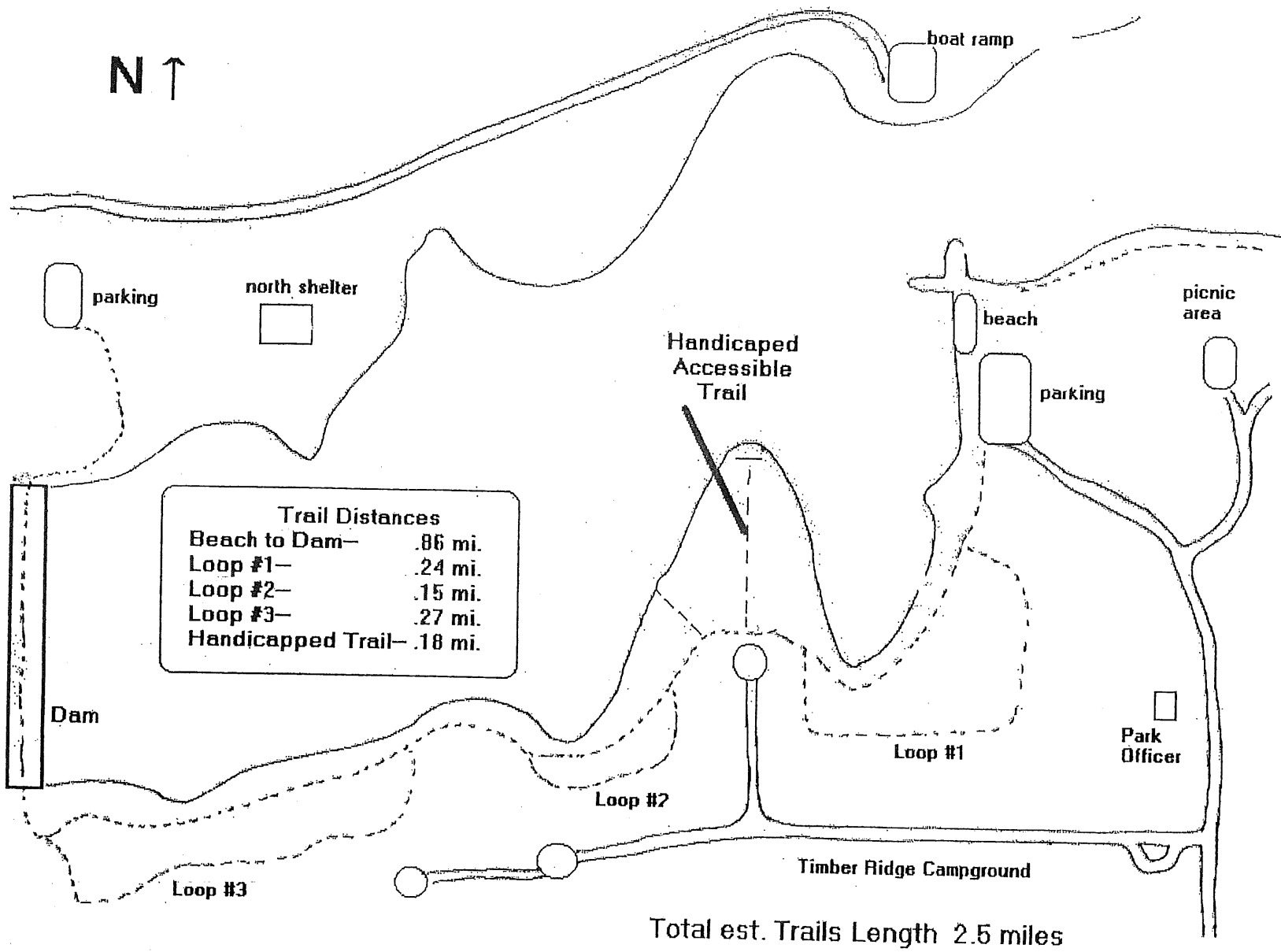
Lake Icaria offers over 4 miles of diverse and challenging nature trails. Along the trail system you can enjoy bird watching, wildlife viewing, climbing series of steps, crossing bridges, and get some needed exercise.

The renovated trail portion includes a handicapped accessible portion of almost .2 miles while the entire trail west of the beach is full of bridges, steps, and new benches in key locations for resting and viewing.

Please be respectful of the trail system, dispose of litter properly, and report any needed repairs to a park officer.

This trail renovation project was financed by a Harkin Wellness Grant administered by the Iowa Department of Public Health, office for Healthy Communities, with funding from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The trail system is maintained by the Adams County Conservation Board.
