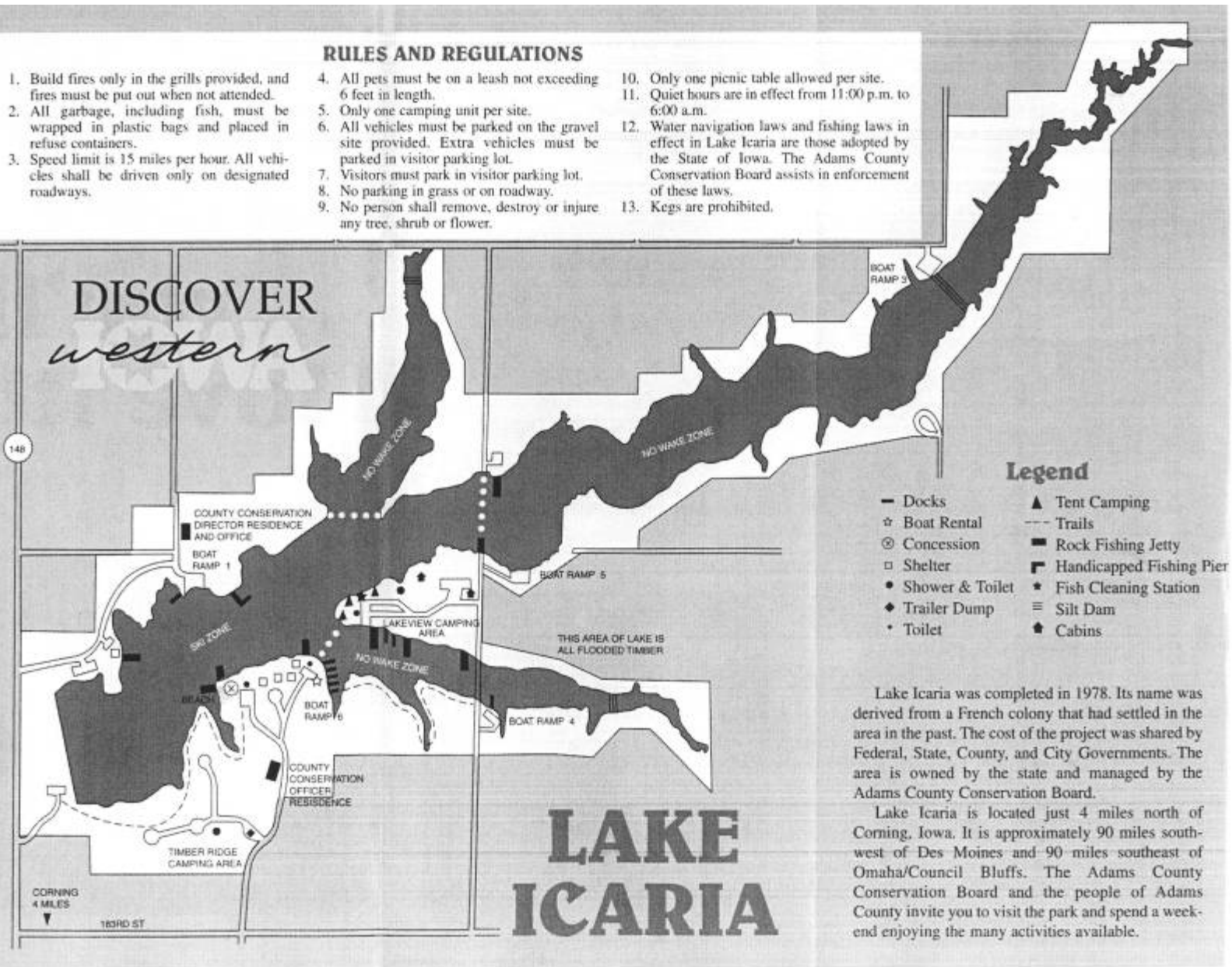


RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Build fires only in the grills provided, and fires must be put out when not attended.
2. All garbage, including fish, must be wrapped in plastic bags and placed in refuse containers.
3. Speed limit is 15 miles per hour. All vehicles shall be driven only on designated roadways.
4. All pets must be on a leash not exceeding 6 feet in length.
5. Only one camping unit per site.
6. All vehicles must be parked on the gravel site provided. Extra vehicles must be parked in visitor parking lot.
7. Visitors must park in visitor parking lot.
8. No parking in grass or on roadway.
9. No person shall remove, destroy or injure any tree, shrub or flower.
10. Only one picnic table allowed per site.
11. Quiet hours are in effect from 11:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
12. Water navigation laws and fishing laws in effect in Lake Icaria are those adopted by the State of Iowa. The Adams County Conservation Board assists in enforcement of these laws.
13. Kegs are prohibited.



Lake Icaria was completed in 1978. Its name was derived from a French colony that had settled in the area in the past. The cost of the project was shared by Federal, State, County, and City Governments. The area is owned by the state and managed by the Adams County Conservation Board.

Lake Icaria is located just 4 miles north of Corning, Iowa. It is approximately 90 miles southwest of Des Moines and 90 miles southeast of Omaha/Council Bluffs. The Adams County Conservation Board and the people of Adams County invite you to visit the park and spend a weekend enjoying the many activities available.
